Centura Athletics COVID-19 Procedures

Centura encourages fans, parents, and guests to wear a mask when unable to social distance. We ask that families sit together and social distance from other groups. Concessions (limited inventory) and restrooms will be available at all our events.

There will not be any team meals allowed before or after games at Centura contests.

Seating at Centura: We ask everyone use the unmarked bleachers. All fans social distance at the concession stand. Encourage a mask when social distancing is impossible.

Before Attending:

- Coaches, players, and fans complete a self-screening
- Self-check for:
 - a fever over 100.4 within the last 24 hours
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Persistent cough
 - Loss of taste and smell
 - Persistent sore throat longer than 24 hours
 - Body aches or chills

Football:

FANS

- All Fans will enter through the main entrance with Centura fans using the South line (left) and the Guests using the North line (right)
- Every other bleacher row will be available. We encourage masks. We ask you social distance unless seated with your family members.
- Home students will be directed to special seating by Principal Bohling to make more bleacher space for fans.
- Guests will sit in the stands, even with and north of the fifty-yard line. The location of This section is away from the score clock. Please, no guest fans on the track.
- All guests are allowed to stand along the fence on the East side of the field while using distancing.

TEAMS

- **Observe and use social distancing in locker rooms.**
- **Encourage masks when social distancing is not possible.**
- **Sidelines observe social distancing**
- **Coaches responsible for equipment disinfectant**
- **Wear masks during transportation**
- **No sharing of water bottles, food, and no buffet team meals.**

Volleyball:

FANS

- Fans can park and enter via the West doors or the East Doors of the Elementary.
- Guest fans will sit on the bleachers behind the scorer's table (West) and the Home fans will use the opposite bleachers (East). We ask everyone to use every other row and social distance.
- Restrooms are available near the concession stand and East entrance. Please social distance when using either.
- Fan attendance will be allowed to reach 800.
- We ask Guest fans to leave two rows behind the team benches to improve the social distancing.
- Coaches will wear masks when unable to social distance.
- Cheerleaders and student body are encouraged to wear a mask at VB games.

TEAMS

- **Observe and use social distancing in locker rooms.**

- **Coaches responsible for equipment disinfectant**
- **Wear masks during transportation**
- **No sharing of water bottles, food, and no buffet team meals.**

Girls Golf

FANS

- Only parents and siblings in the same household may attend unless otherwise stated by the golf course.
- Encouraged to wear a mask around athletes when not social distancing.
- Observe and use social distancing.

TEAM

- No sharing of equipment (clubs, towels, balls, tees, gloves etc)
- Players must physically distance on putting green and driving range with masks on
- Do not remove the flagstick. Courses have implemented measures to prevent touching.
- Coaches will bring scorecards to the tournament director for official scoring.
- Gathering in the clubhouse should be limited as much as possible, primarily for restroom use.
- If bad weather occurs the team will return to the vehicle.
- The team will use social distancing if attending award ceremonies.
- Wear masks during transportation
- No sharing of water bottles, food, and no buffet team meals.

Cross Country

FANS

- Only parents and siblings in the same household may attend unless the host course states differently
- Observe and use social distancing
- Encourage a mask when around the athletes

TEAM

- Teams should be assigned designated team camp areas where athletes should be when not warming up or competing.
- Starting boxes should be spaced appropriately to allow for physical distancing between teams.
- Teams should not report to the starting area until called by the starter.
- Expand the finish chute to reduce crowding - allow space to recover, but encourage to keep moving after the finish to exit chute and return directly to team camp.
- All non-competing team members should be encouraged to stay away from the finish line
- Non-competing members are encouraged to wear a mask when not able to social distance.
- Wear masks during transportation
- No sharing of water bottles, food, and no buffet team meals.

SOFTBALL

FANS

- Fans may attend and follow the guidelines of the host school.
- Observe and use social distancing.
- Wear a mask around the athletes when social distancing is not possible.

TEAM

- Follow the protocol of the host school
- Encourage masks when social distancing is not possible.
- Dugouts observe social distancing and wear a mask
- Coaches responsible for equipment disinfectant
- Wear masks during transportation
- No sharing of water bottles, food, and no buffet team meals.
